- 2. Do a search on "Nuyts". Who was he and what purpose would it serve for the Japanese to kidnap him?

- 1. Based on the image, what is the topographical make-up of Taiwan?
- 2. Based on the image, what challenges might Taiwan's topography present for Dutch conquest?

PAGE 2, IMAGE 1 Birds eye view of Tayoun and Fort Zeelandia

- 1. Based on the image, why might the Dutch have decided to build a fort on a peninsula off the coast of Taiwan rather than on the island itself?
- 2. Based on the image, how well did the Dutch establish themselves at Fort Zeelandia?

PAGE 2, IMAGE 7 Map of the Strait of Taiwan

- 1. Zooming in on the map and reading the text description below the image, what can you infer about the Dutch trading presence in the Strait of Taiwan in the 17th century?
- 2. Which land mass appears to the left of Taiwan? Based on the map, what kind of trading relationship did the Dutch have with them?

- 2. Based on your knowledge of the era, who was the power that defeated the Dutch?
